MEMORY VERSE: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek His will in all you do, and He will show you which path to take." Proverbs 3:5-6

Proverbs 2:1-2 My child, listen to what I say, and treasure my commands.

Tune your ears to wisdom, and concentrate on understanding.

4:20-22 My child, pay attention to what I say. Listen carefully to My words.

Don't lose sight of them. Let them penetrate deep into your heart,

for they bring life to those who find them, and healing to their whole body.

1:33 But all who listen to Me will live in peace, untroubled by fear of harm.

8:32 And so, my children, listen to Me, for all who follow My ways are joyful.

3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek His will in all you do, and He will show you which path to take.

4:25-27 Look straight ahead, and fix your eyes on what lies before you.

Mark out a straight path for your feet; stay on the safe path.

Don't get sidetracked; keep your feet from following evil.

10:9 People with integrity walk safely, but those who follow crooked paths will be exposed.

13:6 Godliness guards the path of the blameless, but the evil are misled by sin.

4:13 Take hold of My instructions; don't let them go. Guard them, for they are the key to life.

7:2-3 Obey My commands and live! Guard My instructions as you guard your own eyes. Tie them on your fingers as a reminder. Write

them deep within your heart.

19:16 Keep the commandments and keep your life; despising them leads to death.16:7 When people's lives please the Lord,

even their enemies are at peace with them.

14:22b If you plan to do good, you will receive unfailing love and faithfulness.

21:3 The Lord is more pleased when we do what is right and just than when we offer him sacrifices.

Micah 6:8 O people, the Lord has told you...
what He requires of you:

to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.

Wisdom: God-given understanding, ability to distinguish between right and wrong, insight, discernment. The ability to look at life from God's point of view and then choosing to live it out through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Fear of the Lord: profound reverence and awe toward God; respect for God's character, words, actions and position that leads to love and obedience; true honor, devotion and surrender to God.

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
