- 6. Lies harm ourselves, others, and our relationship with God. How have you experienced this in your life?




























- 7. According to Ephesians 4:15, how are we supposed to speak? What do you think this means?
- 8. Read Colossians 3:9-10. Why aren't we supposed to lie as Christians? What does it mean to put off the old self and it's ways?
- 9. From the above two verses, who are we to be like? What do you think that looks like?
- 10. This lesson shows us that our words can either be untruthful and harmful, or they can be truthful and filled with love. Are you representing God well with the words you speak?

BELIEVE THE TRUTH

The Ninth Commandment tells us to not lie, to not tell stories that are untrue about people. When you tell a lie, you hurt yourself as well as others. Sometimes telling the truth is not easy; in fact, it can be downright unpleasant. But we are called to be truth-tellers, so that all our friends and family want to know God like we do! God's love for us drives out fear, and He promises to help us if we tell the truth.

PRAY THE TRUTH

Dear God, thank you for your commandments that are meant for my good. Please help me to take lying as seriously as You do. Give me the courage to speak truth always, especially when it is hard. And help me to be more and more like You everyday. Amen.
