7. What does God tell us in Isaiah 46:10 about the future?

8. What does Psalm 18:30 say about God's way and His promises? What does this mean in your life?

9. God is all-powerful and all-knowing, How do we know this based on Psalm 147:5 and Isaiah 40:28?

10. How does learning about God's character impact you? How should we respond? (See memory verse for one of many ways.)

Who Is God?

Isaiah 46:9b: “For I alone am God! I am God, and there is none like me.”

Psalms 147:5: “How great is our Lord! His power is absolute! His understanding is beyond comprehension!”

Isaiah 40:28: “Have you never heard? Have you never understood? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of all the earth. He never grows weak or weary. No one can measure the depths of his understanding.”
