Written

To the Jewish people to record the origins of the Feast of Lots, or Purim.

Synopsis

The book is named for a young Jewish girl named Hadassah who was taken from her guardian, Mordecai, and forced to a compete for the affection of the king. This unlikely contestant for beauty pageant was crowned queen of Persia and renamed Esther, meaning "star." Haman, a high official of the king, plots to destroy all the Jews in the kingdom, but Mordecai hears of the plot and reports it to Esther. Esther outwits Haman and takes her petition to the king and pleas for the protection of her Jewish people.
